



Class-Day Checklist

A simple planning sheet for students before CPR Safety 411 training. Use it with the What to Expect page for the most current class details.

Before you go: Confirm your class time, location, and any instructions sent with your registration. If something is unclear, use CPR Safety 411's What to Expect page or contact CPR Safety 411 before class day.

Confirm your class details

■	Class date and start time Check your registration message or reminder so you arrive on time.
■	Training location or online access Confirm the address, room details, parking notes, or virtual access information.
■	Course type Know which class you are taking, such as BLS, CPR & AED, First Aid, Pediatric First Aid & CPR, or another CPR Safety 411 course.

Bring what you may need

■	Photo ID if requested Bring identification if your class instructions, employer, or organization requires it.
■	Registration details Keep your confirmation email, receipt, or class message handy on your phone.
■	Comfort items Wear comfortable clothes and bring water or personal items you normally need during training.

After class reminders

■	Watch for certification information Check the email address used for registration and follow the provider instructions when your certification information is available.
■	Save your proof Once available, save a copy, screenshot, card image, or share link for your records.
■	Know where to get help Use the After Class page for post-class guidance and the Verify Certification page when verification is needed.
